L'Acadie Blanc are a Canadian variety. The grapes are known to be a very hearty, disease resistant variety that produces a very bright, well balanced, dry white wine.

Wines from this grape are known to have distinctive apple notes and our own L'Acadie Blanc has been compared to a more full bodied Pinot Grigio. This grape is considered to be Nova Scotia's signature white wine variety.



"Generations" L'Acadie Blanc pairs very well with white fish, scallops, charcuterie boards, creamy pasta dishes, or, as recommended by Frank himself, either a Thai green curry dish, roasted fingerling potatoes, or greens with a lemon ginger dressing.
