Our Hessenland Schatz "Sisters" Rose is a beautiful blend of white and red, named for the two youngest sisters of the Ihrig family. "Sisters" Rose is an 11.8% off-dry wine, with a beautiful light salmon colour. This wine is the blend of 94% "Blume" Vidal, and 6% "Musuko" Marquette. It has gorgeous aromas of strawberry, cherry, and mango, with a little bit of ginger spice. The palate is wonderfully fresh with wild strawberry and a hint of minerality and a fresh citrus peel finish that leaves you wanting more!

As mentioned when we talked about "Blume" Vidal, the Vidal grape is extremely versatile and produces high quality, medium body, off dry white wines, and is even flexible enough to be able to make ice wines and late harvest wines.

The Marquette is a distant relative of Pinot Noir and produces very complex medium bodies wines with well balanced tannins and a beautiful ruby red colour.



"Sisters" Rose tends to be a fan favourite for bridal showers, tour groups, and everything in between! This is the perfect wine with pizza or purely on its own! It's light and fresh which makes it a great choice for anything from a relaxing evening in to a fun night with friends!
